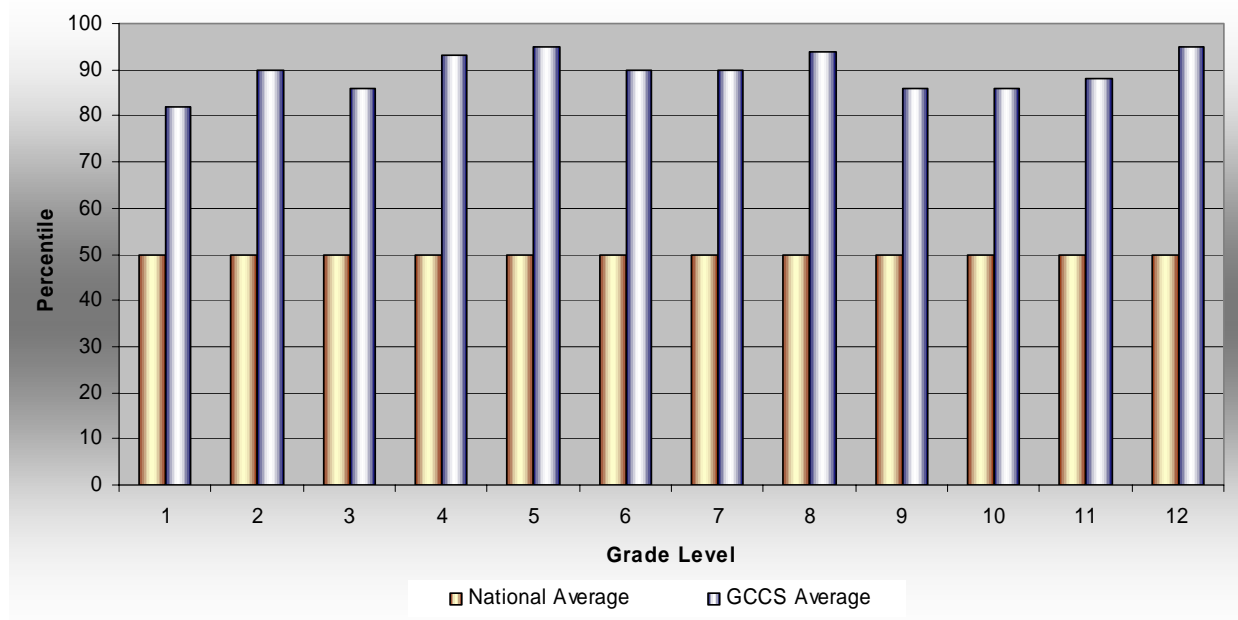


Achievement Tests

Notes:
